Scottish Cup winners 1873-74*

*The Scottish Football Association was founded at a meeting held in Dewar's Temperance Hotel on Bridge Street, Glasgow on the 13 March 1873. The Scottish Challenge Cup was also established. Seven clubs attended the meeting: Clydesdale, Dumbreck, Eastern, Granville, Queen's Park, 3rd Lanark RV and Vale of Leven. Although Kilmarnock didn't attend they had sent a letter stating their willingness to join.*

*At this time, all these clubs initially contributed £1 each towards the cost of the purchasing a trophy and by the time the cup was produced by George Edward & Sons, the sum of £41 12s had been raised as follows; Clydesdale and Queens Park (£5 each), Western (£4), 3rd Lanark RV and Alexandria Athletic (£3 each), Dumbreck and Granville (2 guineas each), Dumbarton (£1 10s), Rovers (£1 5s), Kilmarnock, Renton, Callander, Blythswood, Eastern and Vale of Leven (all £1). This was raised to £41 12s through further donations. With the finished trophy and badges costing £56 12s the SFA were allowed extra time to raise the balance.*
